

SCENARistylér: graphic customization for all

🕒 **Duration:** 1 day

This training takes place remotely, in synchronous mode, via a webconference system allowing the use of video, sound, chat and screen sharing (trainee/trainer).

The goal of this training is to learn how to create new *skins* of web or paper generators of a Scenari publishing chain.

Did you know?

SCENARistylér offers a "form" mode that allows one to create a graphical customization for the documents of an open source publishing chain without any prerequisites.

Though, if you want to go further into graphic customization, this training is for you! It is based on guided and free modes.

Prerequisites

- Know the publishing chain to customize and be comfortable with its use.
- Know the HTML/CSS style principles.

For who?

👤 **Target audience:** Technical profile.

This training is aimed at computer graphics designers, webmasters... in charge of the graphic design of documents from the Scenari editorial chain.

Objectives

Know how to adapt the graphic designs of documents produced with a Scenari editorial chain.

This training allows you to start your skin modification project in good conditions: you are invited to bring graphic elements, guidelines, vector images... which will allow you to put it into practice immediately.

Program

The training is divided into two half-days. It is recommended to work on your project between the two sessions.

Session 1

- Presentation of SCENARistylér and its principles;
- Exploring an example skin with CSS;
- Presentation of the structure of the CSS of the publishing chain to be styled;
- Experimentation (handling).

Session 2

- Questions and answers;
- Further styling;
- Presentation of the paper skin principle and its modification;
- Skin packaging, choice of version numbers.

OpenDocument support

Depending on your needs, this training can go deeper into the styling of the Open Document type document.

Pedagogy and tools

Educational principles

The training is focused on the practice: the manipulation of SCENARichain and its extension SCENARistylér through exercises.

Tools

- The *wspacks* of your publishing chain or of an open source publishing chain,
- SCENARichain and the extension SCENARistylér.

Organization

A trainer can assist a **maximum of 4 trainees** during the training.
